#### UPLIFT Florida Network Launches Village Development



The <u>Village to Village Network</u> was engaged in a national conversation, Reimagining Villages, to explore new models for the funding and operation of villages with aspirations of inclusivity and the desire to thrive independently. In response, <u>UPLIFT Florida Network</u> was formed to facilitate a new village system using a hub and spoke model.

UPLIFT has been supported in its development by The Patterson Foundation and Sarasota County's Aging Systems Policy Coordinator, Sue Berger, and mentored by several individuals from the Village to Village Network—the national organization that supports more than 300 existing villages in the United States. This support has given UPLIFT the confidence and guidance to create an innovative, second-generation model for the development of villages.

## CallConnect is Entering Its Soft Launch Phase

UPLIFT is expanding CallConnect, a calling program designed to reach individuals wanting a greater connection with others.
CallConnect launched its pilot program in July 2021 using the CallHub system developed by the Motion Picture and Television Fund (MPTF) in California. Going forward, CallHub will be operated by a spinoff from MPTF called Determined Health.

We hope to serve individuals who wish to have meaningful conversations with others who have similar interests or experiences. Participants in the program simply use their existing phone to call through the CallConnect software system.
